## **Summary**

Before upgrading GV-ASManager V2.3 to newer versions, you need to back up the database first if you are using MDB database, and then restore the database to the upgraded version.

## **To Back Up Database**

Follow the steps below to back up the database before upgrading GV-ASManager V2.3 to newer versions.

1. Go to :\Access Control\ASManager\ASRes\ and there should be four files.

3. Uninstall GV-ASManager V2.3. After uninstalling, only two files remain in the ASRes folder.

- 4. Install GV-ASManager V3.0 or later versions.
- 5. Copy and paste the four files you backed up back to :\Access Control\ASManager\ASRes.
- 6. Run ASDBManager.exe from the program folder at :\Access Control\ASManager.
- 7. Select ASManager Database Setting.



8. Select Upgrade to latest database version.
