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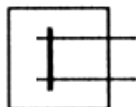
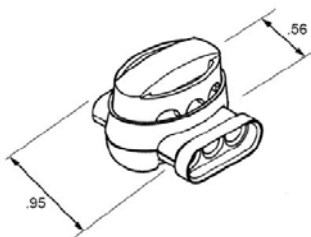
Installation Technique



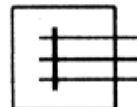
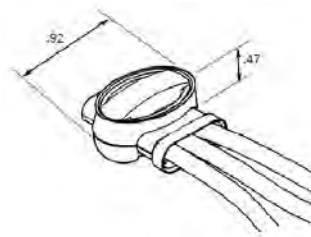
WARNING

Turn power off before installing or removing terminal. All electrical work should be done according to appropriate electrical codes.

1. Insert 2 or 3 un-stripped conductors completely into connector and check their position by looking through the translucent body.
2. Hold toll perpendicular to the conductors and make the connection by driving the cap down flush with the top edge of the connector body.
